EXPLANATION:

This emergency order closes the state of Alaska resident and nonresident moose hunt for the Gustavus Forelands, moose hunt RM049.

REGULATORY TEXT:

Therefore, the provisions of 5 AAC 85.045, HUNTING SEASONS AND BAG LIMITS FOR MOOSE, are superseded by this emergency order, and the following provisions are effective for hunting moose in Unit 1(C):

**JUSTIFICATION:**

(Juneau) – Prior to the season ADF&G set a harvest quota for the Gustavus area registration moose hunt, RM049, of 12 bulls for harvest in this hunt. This quota was met on the evening of October 7, 2022. We are instituting an Emergency Order closing the season at 11:59 pm October 9, 2022 because this year's quota has been filled.

**An Emergency Order (01-12-22) was issued that closes RM049 moose season in this area on Sunday, October 9, 2022 @ 11:59 pm.**

The remaining registration moose regulations in Unit 1C are unchanged and are not affected by this Emergency Order.
